Poster Presentations:

Posters will be allocated to one of the four poster sessions and should be attended by the presenter for discussion on the day of presentation.

Please may we ask you to inform us on the name of the presenter if you will not attend the ESDAR conference.

Poster dimensions:

The height of the poster boards is **2,0 meter (78,7 inches)** and the width is **0,95 meter (37,4 inches)**.

Materials required to mount posters will be available.

Poster Display

Posters should be mounted on Thursday 10 September (18h00-20h00) or at the latest on Friday 11 September before 09h55 and left on display till Saturday 12 September 17h15.

Posters not removed before 18h00 on Saturday 12 September will be considered as paper waste.

Poster Sessions

Posters are allocated into 4 different sessions (see attachment):

Presenting authors are asked to attend their poster during the Poster Sessions, as indicated here:

Poster session I: on Friday 11 September (14h00-15h30)
odd- numbered posters: P-01 - P-91

Poster session II: on Friday 11 September (16h00-17h30)
odd- numbered posters P-93 - P-2075

Poster Session III: on Saturday 12 September (11h00-12h30)
numbered posters P-02 - P-104

Poster Session IV: on Saturday 12 September (15h30-17h00)
numbered posters P-106 - P-206

Our suggestions for an effective poster presentation:

Type size:

The title should be printed across the top of the poster in characters of at least 84 pt.

Author(s) and affiliation should be at least 42 pt.

Text, including figures and tables, should be no smaller than 24 pt. All parts of the poster should be easily read from a distance of 1,20 meter (47,2 inches)

For ease of viewing, convert tables into figures whenever possible. Any tables should be simple and should contain no extraneous materials.

Use as few abbreviations as possible.

Provide a brief, clear caption for each figure so that the reader does not have to flip the text to understand the figure.

End your conclusion section with a two sentence “take-home” message
