

## **Announcement: Residency Position in Animal Reproduction (emphasis small animal reproduction)**

The Department of Companion Animals and Horses at the University of Veterinary Medicine Vienna offers a position for a resident in Animal Reproduction (emphasis small animal reproduction) in the Section for Artificial Insemination and Embryo Transfer (Supervisor: ao.Univ.Prof. Dr. Sabine Schäfer-Somi)

Start: July 1st, 2010

The University of Veterinary Medicine Vienna is a renowned academic teaching institution with excellent facilities for research and animal care. The Animal Hospital and University have state-of-the-art equipment and a wide range of specialist services.

The Residency Programme in Animal Reproduction (emphasis small animal reproduction) is a 3 year programme designed to provide advanced clinical training in animal reproduction. The Resident will be assigned to the Section for Artificial Insemination and Embryo Transfer (Head Prof. Dr. Christine Aurich) but will also participate in the clinical work of the Section for Obstetrics, Gynaecology and Andrology. The programme will emphasize on small animal reproduction but the resident will also be exposed to equine and production animal reproductive cases. The training will permit the resident to achieve the requirements established by the European College of Animal Reproduction (ECAR) for Diplomate certification. The resident is thus expected to study towards the European Diploma in Animal Reproduction. The resident is further expected to complete at least one research project resulting in a manuscript suitable for publication, and to present the research at an international meeting. Personal development time is provided for this and to prepare for the qualifying examination of the college.

Applicants must have successfully completed a 12-months rotating or specific internship or have gained equivalent experience. Further, candidates need to have sufficient knowledge of the German and English language to communicate with clients and to understand the certifying exam.

Applications should include a letter of intent, curriculum vitae, exam transcripts, veterinary licensing documentation, internship diploma or proof of equivalent qualification, and at least two letters of recommendation. An interview is strongly encouraged but not required.

Appointments will be made for 12 months with annual renewal based on satisfactory completion of the previous year.
